

The **treasurers report** was given by Ken Lauffer, Treasurer. Checkbook is balanced through April 30, with a balance of \$13,438.93 with \$6,071.11 in operating account and \$7,367.82 in the CAP fund. Allocated CAP fund money is \$5,100 for Brown Deer bag stands and a score board at Dretzka. The treasurers report was accepted.

**Second team** was discussed by Director Brian Pederson. The first event was held at Brown Deer. There was some confusion noted about what tees to play by one group and there was also an issue with some groups not knowing about the lift clean and place to start. Some other individuals played the local rule for a lost ball or OB which was not in effect. It was discussed that since the match is in group and the fact that a player can take an X on a hole there was nothing to do at this time, but it was decided that any unusual changes should be communicated with a rules sheet to be affixed to the official score card.
