Minutes from MCPLA meeting

Chet Hendrickson provided an update on the opening of the Milwaukee County Courses. They will open on Friday April 24<sup>th</sup> but will be walking only. The pro shop will not be open but a county employee will be at the course to verify payment. Limited items can be purchased by letting the employee know what is wanted and they will get it out of the shop. Bathrooms will be available. Cups will be filled with a foam insert that will keep the ball from going to the bottom of the hole and pins must remain in. All tee times must be made online. No lessons, no rainchecks, they would prefer prepay but Chet did indicate that payment could be made at the course but they would prefer limiting that exposure so one person can submit the payment for the whole group. Tee times will be 15 minute increments through 5/15 then 10 minute tee times from 5/16-5/26.i

The Spring Championship is still on. The flyer was emailed out, Bob Freuck would appreciate an updated email list from each club to get the flyer to everyone. The event at this time will be walking only with 10-minute tee times.

Second Team, the first event is scheduled for Oakwood on May 23<sup>rd</sup>. At this time that looks like it would be walking only. An email will be sent to the captains to determine if all 7 teams can fill 12 people able to walk the course. Second team usually has over 1/3 of the field in carts. If by May 9, the County still is not allowing carts out, and any team cannot fill 12 walkers the event will be cancelled.

The North vs South challenge matches are replacing First Team. These will be 2-Man scratch events. The North will be Currie, Dretzka and Brown Deer, Captained by Chris Glinski. The South will be Oakwood, Whitnall, Greenfield and Grant, Captained by Steve G. The first event is scheduled for May 9th at Whitnall.
