MCPLA Meeting Minutes

Attending the meeting were the following club representatives: Brown Deer 1, Currie 3, Dretzka 2, Grant 3, Greenfield 2, Oakwood 4 and Whitnall 3.

The minutes from the last meeting were accepted as posted.

The treasurer's report was given with \$16,182.94 in the account made up of \$9,263.41 in operating and \$6,919.53 in the CAP fund. Deposits for the spring tournament are \$2,230.24.

Second team event coming up at the end of May, the roster requests have been sent out. Russ Hinz is working on getting the scoring in Golf Genius. Testing will be completed in the next couple weeks.

John Kugel from Oakwood has volunteered to act as a rules official for MCPLA events. Thank you John.

A proposal to purchase expanded use of BlueGolf was brought to vote. The cost would be \$499 per year currently. This would allow MCPLA to be treated as a club of its own and scores to be posted after the events. You would still sign up on the MCPLA site. Depending on future costs of the license a dues increase may be requested. The service could also be cancelled if it is not deemed worthwhile.

Chet Hendrickson provided an update on course conditions. Dretzka is opening on Friday May 5. There have been several employees that left due to the pandemic and vaccine requirements specifically at Dretzka. Currie has a lot of water on the 17th hole and has no carts currently like usual in spring.

A new pro has been hired for Greenfield Nic Dooley is the new pro and he came over from GolfTec Brookfield.

The Ryder cup roster is due to Tim Neilson on June 11. Grant was concerned as they do not have 6 players in their club under 10 index. This will be discussed by the Ryder cup committee.

The next meeting is July 5 starting at 6:30 in the Currie clubhouse.
